EMPLOYEE GIVING

In 2025, REV employees turned small ripples of generosity into waves of impact. Every dollar, totaling \$9,746, helped build more resilient communities while advancing Vision 2030. COMMUNITY EVENTS



CHARLESTON WINE + FOOD (SOUTH CAROLINA)

REV was honored to support the Charleston Wine + Food Community Impact Awards, celebrating the people and passion that shape the Lowcountry's vibrant culinary community. This meaningful partnership reflects a shared commitment to nurturing talent, expanding opportunity, and uplifting the region through mentorship, education, and connection. Helping ensure the culinary and hospitality community continues to thrive for years to come is an impactful way to #UpTheGood.

REV DAY GIVEBACK (SOUTH CAROLINA)

REV invited Surfers Healing to REV Day 2025 for an on-stage check presentation as part of February's giveback. Surfers Healing, founded in 1996, is the original surf camp for children with autism. REV's \$3,000 donation will help offset camp costs, including travel expenses for campers who may not otherwise be able to attend.

AZALEA FESTIVAL FASHION SHOW (NORTH CAROLINA)

For the second consecutive year, REV powered the 2025 Azalea Spring Fashion Show in partnership with the North Carolina Azalea Festival. REV took this opportunity to showcase local artist and textile painter, Sydney Durrett, and featured runway models who are making significant strides in the community, including Christina Haley, President and CEO of Wilmington Downtown Inc. The event also highlighted a nonprofit supporting victims of domestic violence, with Operation Pretty Things receiving a \$5,000 donation from the #UpTheGood Foundation during the final runway moment of the show.

COMMUNITY EVENTS



THE CITADEL ATHLETICS (SOUTH CAROLINA)

In 2025, REV and The Citadel teamed up to launch a dedicated scholarship to benefit Veteran Day students. This scholarship launched through #UpTheGood Foundation honors REV's military heritage and ongoing commitment to those who serve.

The #UpTheGood Scholarship was announced with a \$10,000 contribution at the season's first football game, with additional funding raised throughout the season through per-score donations tied to field goals, extra points, and 3-pointers made by the Bulldogs.



REV ROCKS CONCERT SERIES (NORTH CAROLINA)

The REV Rocks Concert Series, brought live music and community impact together at Greenfield Lake Amphitheater. Featuring artists such as 49 Winchester, Flipturn, and The Revivalists, the series also highlighted local nonprofits through the #UpTheGood tent, encouraging engagement and volunteerism. Over the season, \$5,000 in mini grants were awarded to 10 local nonprofits.



RECESS AT THE LAKE (NORTH CAROLINA)

REV hosted the inaugural Recess at the Lake, a community fitness and wellness event benefiting the #UpTheGood Foundation, at Greenfield Lake Amphitheater. The event brought the community together for a lively morning of fitness, food, and giving, featuring multiple group exercise classes with proceeds supporting the Foundation. The event also highlighted 3Wheel Therapy, a local nonprofit whose mission to expand access to wellness and joyful experiences closely reflected the spirit of Recess at the Lake.



GAME OF GIVE (SOUTH CAROLINA)

REV and the Charleston RiverDogs teamed up for a fun filled evening of Baseball at the first annual Game of Give. This newly launched #UpTheGood signature event was an opportunity to recognize representatives and volunteers from 51 local nonprofit organizations.

As part of the Game of Give, the #UpTheGood Foundation held onsite activations, including awarding \$500 grants to two attending nonprofits in recognition of their community resilience work.

GIVING TUESDAY

REV members and team members came together in an inspiring show of generosity on Giving Tuesday. Together, they raised \$1,643 in support of the #UpTheGood Foundation. This year's campaign emphasized a simple belief: giving truly has a good ring to it, especially when it helps put toys in the hands of children who could use a little extra joy this holiday season.

Contributions made on Giving Tuesday directly supported local nonprofits through in-kind donations aimed at brightening the season for families facing hardship.
